The academic year commenced on June 3rd 2024 with a special assembly invoking divine blessings, a beautiful reminder of the enduring legacy we uphold. The day also marked our foundation Day celebration, a time to reflect on the glorious journey of Holy Trinity Vidyabhavan and renew our commitment to the values that shape our future.

Achievements that inspire - CBSE result

The success of our students in the Board Examinations of 2023 – 24 stands as a shining testament to their exceptional achievement of securing a 100% pass in both classes X and XII fills us with immense pride and joy. This remarkable accomplishment showcases not just their academic diligence but the strength of the values instilled in them through the years of Holy Trinity Vidyabhavan. 53 students appeared for class XII. In Science Adithyan R 97.2% stood first followed by Binta Anna Jacob 90.4%, and Ahadha Fathima 90%. In Commerce the toppers are Sofiya Joseph 90.6%, Sam Pothen Peter 89.2%, Vinayak S 82%. For class X 75 students appeared for the exam and the school topper was Armiya Das 96.2% followed by Ardhra Ajay 96% and Adrija Pushpajan and Aiswarya Rajeev securing 95.4% at third place.

To honour these young achievers a grand felicitation ceremony was held on our foundation Day. Their efforts were proudly recognised by the management with cash awards being presented, while the PTA contributed meaningful mementoes to celebrate their success. The toppers Class X and XII received Mayoogham Merit award from Shri. Ramesh Chennithala, MLA.

Empowering Educators and Students Alike

Understanding the importance of staying ahead in a dynamic educational environment, we organised a series of workshops for our teachers. These sessions along with webinars and training programs conducted by CBSE, Sahodaya and book publishers, equipped our educators with the latest methodologies to enrich their teaching practices.

Beyond Academics – A Platform for Excellence

From district to state level contests, they have proudly brought home honours in various categories from academics to the arts and sports. In the Sahodaya District level Kalotsav held at Padmasree Central School, Adoor and S N Central School, Kayamkulam our school secured over all second position with 855 points. Our students displayed their excellence in the CBSE state Kalotsav held at Ahalya Public School Palakkad and secured 21st position among 700 schools. 41 students got A grade and in 3 group items also we secured A grade. I would like to appreciate and place on record the achievement of Devanandana S of XI, for securing 2nd prize in Cartoon and 3rd prize for poster making in the State level competition.

We are extremely proud of Aiswarya S of class IX for her astonishing performance in securing Gold medal in Tug of War and Bronze medal in Cycle Polo in the National level Championship held at Maharashtra.




